We're about to start something wonderful and we need your help.

As a key cultural, social and economic partner within the city of Chichester, the South of England and a national cultural leader and change maker, CFT want to do more to fuel the future national creative workforce both locally and nationally. With Justin and Kathy at the helm, we have a clear vision for the future.

There's an increasingly urgent need for more space to develop creative projects and support emerging artists. So, we're planning to open a new and exciting venue here on the CFT site to nurture the theatre makers of tomorrow. Nestled in the trees beside the Festival Theatre, with sustainability at its heart, what better name for this space to incubate creativity in our community, hatch new work in progress and nurture growing artists, than The Nest.

For us to create The Nest and have it ready for Festival 2025, we need to raise at least $\mathfrak{L}1.5$ million by March 2025. We've set aside $\mathfrak{L}250,000$ from our own reserves to kickstart the Fundraising Appeal and all of our Board have made pledges.

Our challenge

CFT urgently needs a third space to:


- test projects and productions at their early stages and develop short courses and workshops
- be the home of our Emerging Artists
 Development Programme
- offer 'breakout' rehearsal spaces (the Steven Pimlott Building is at capacity)
- work with more families and small children.
- give our key community partners a safe space to meet

Our solution

To solve these challenges, we plan to open a new venue and it is a big part of Justin's vision for the future of CFT. He sees CFT fuelling the future national creative workforce; this is a robust offering locally, but we also confidently stand our ground as a national cultural leader and change maker.

With sustainability at its heart, we have found an ideal structure previously located at the Pleasance Theatre in London and used at the Edinburgh Festival. Usable year-round and fully wheelchair accessible, this 119-seater studio will have a thrust-stage to match our sister theatres and removeable stacked seating giving us plenty of flexibility.


Repurposed and fitted out with existing kit, it will be used by the community and for family classes, late night events, fringe-style performances, a rehearsal room for students and a base for our new Artists Development Programme.


